Stall Reservations: USE AT YOUR OWN RISK

Stalls are available for rent through the Town of Payson for \$15 per stall/per day. Please reserve and make payment for your stall(s) by Friday, May 12, 2017 **by registering on-line** at www.paysonrimcountry.com. Stall payments are non-refundable. Stall fees after the May 12th deadline are \$25 per stall/day and will be on-site only. **NO REFUNDS.**

Safety First: No tie-outs. If you don't rent stalls from the Town of Payson you can bring your own fence panels.

Stall Management: Once you've pre-registered on-line, your name will be on the quantity of stalls that you reserved/paid for. Please do not put a horse in a stall until you have paid and your name is on the stall. There will be an additional fee of \$25 for using non-issued stalls. Shavings are not included; however, there are local feed & supply stores—**Pet Club:** (928) 474-4165, and **Tractor Supply:** (928) 474-2829.

Facility Improvement Fee

This is a mandatory one-time per event flat fee of \$5 that is added to every stall rental transaction or dry camp fee or combination there-of. This fee is applied toward facility improvements.

Shop Payson

Water, Manure & Trash

Water: There are three spigots available for horse watering purposes located under the treed area just north of the horse pens. **Manure:** There is a manure dumping area located adjacent to the stalls. **Trash:** There will be multiple trash receptacles located throughout the facility along with dumpsters. Please throw away your trash appropriately.

Fire Restrictions

For safety measures, campfires and use of charcoal are not allowed; however, gas grills are allowed.

Adult Beverages & Glass Containers

The consumption of alcoholic beverages is prohibited. Alcohol use is only allowed through the Pro-Rodeo liquor license and stipulations. Additionally, please do not bring/use beverages in glass bottle containers.
